



NNL EVALUATION CRITERIA AND KPI LIBRARY

The NNL Evaluation Criteria and Key Performance Indicator Library serves the following functions:

- Master source of all evaluation criteria which should be utilised by NNL buyers
- Underpins the NNL P&SC Scorecard enabling the golden thread to be traced between a project business case right through contract delivery
- Provides a comprehensive list of SQ questions and ITT questions, linked to successful project delivery and the NNL P&SC Scorecard
- Agreed evaluation criteria and KPIs, set by senior leaders in NNL, to reflect their ambitions and workstreams
- Continues to act as the repository for new evaluation criteria development and KPIs that are produced by NNL senior leaders to ensure appropriate alignment and consistent application



Evaluation Criteria and Key Performance Indicator Library



PPE & UNIFORMS

THEN

- Daily (sometimes twice) deliveries from supplier to Workington site for security reasons (30 mile round trip x 5/week)
- NNL Driver transports to Sellafield site daily (25 mile round trip x 5/week)
- Sellafield truck takes to relevant building (electric vehicle)

NOW

- Weekly deliveries to Sellafield off-site depot (20 mile round trip x 1/week)
- Sellafield truck takes to relevant building (electric vehicle)
- CO2 savings of 7.5t annually
- Man hour savings ~20,000/annum

FACILITY REFURB DELIVERY PARTNER

- 15 KPIs linked to Scorecard, including
 - Apprenticeships
 - Use of SMEs in area
 - Efficiency targets (new ways of working)
 - Carbon Reduction targets
 - Knowledge Share / Transfer
 - Training & Development of NNL staff
 - Graduate placements
 - ED&I monitoring
 - Sponsorship of PhD's



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
