Your energy is split into two sections:

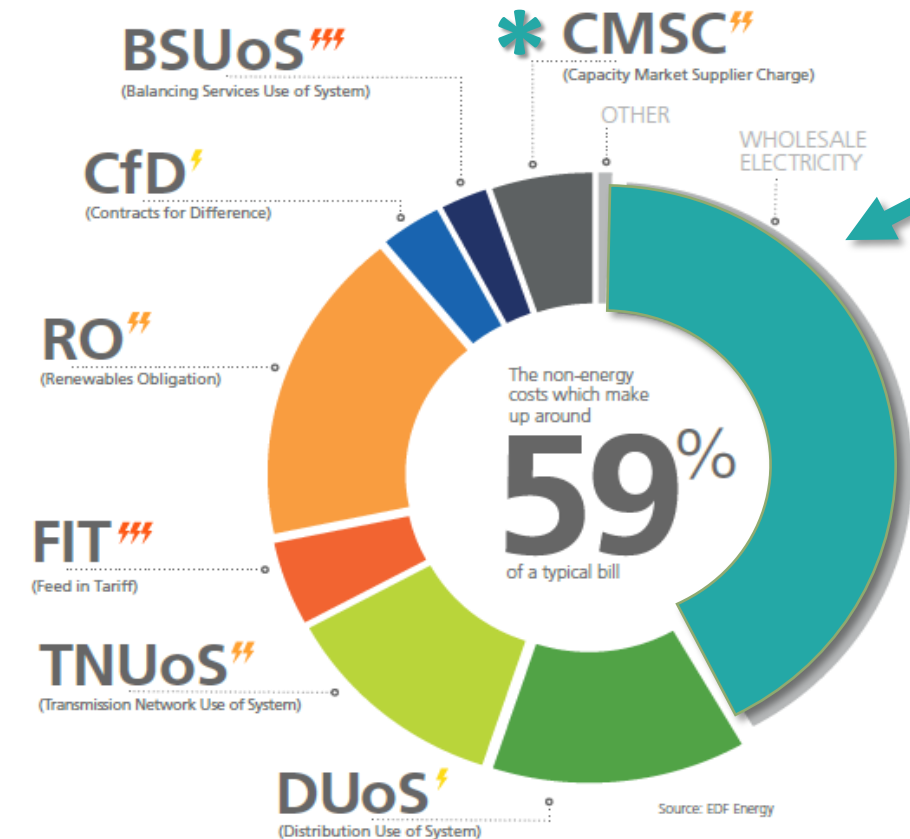
Commodity:

This is the actual electricity/ gas you use, and the part you can influence through the purchasing strategy you select.

Non-Commodity: *(everything else)*

These are all the added extras that cannot be controlled through a purchasing strategy. This includes the following:

- FiT (Feed in Tariff)
- RO (Renewables Obligation)
- CfD (Contracts for Difference)
- BSUoS, TNUoS and DUoS (Transmission & Distribution system charges)

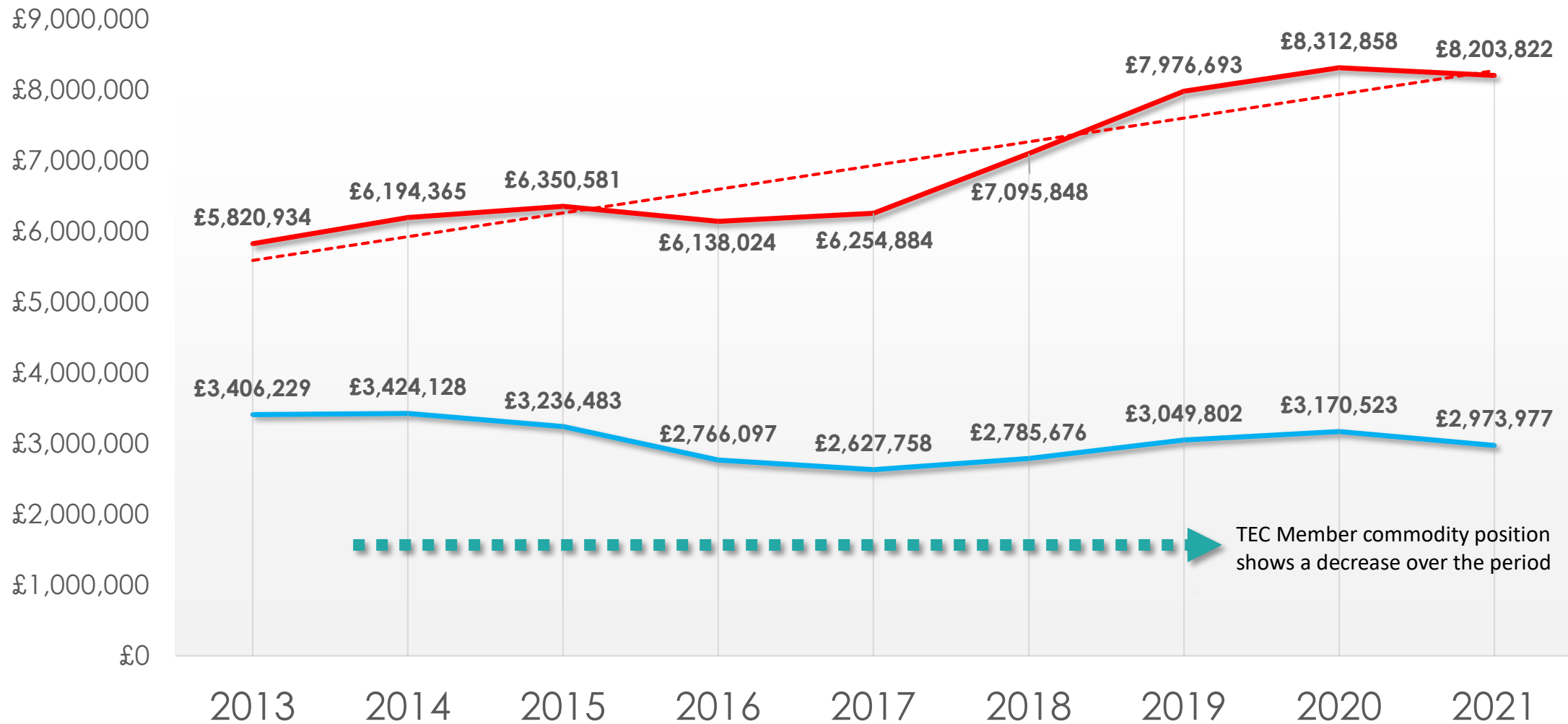
